2 World Masters Games in Kansai

The world's largest lifelong sport international event, "World Masters Games in Kansai" will be held in the late May of 2021. The sailing competitions held will be one person dinghy, Laser class, Laser Radial class, two person dinghy Tasar class, and inclusive class Hansa 303. The venue is the Wakayama Sailing Club, which held the 2009 Tasar World, and the schedule and other details are as shown in the attached sheet.

The Japan Tasar Association plans to prepare some charter boats for foreign participants. In addition, we request the tournament executive committee, which is the organizer, to provide transportation cost support for container transportation of boats from overseas. The notice of race is scheduled to be released in November, and we are expecting many Tasar Sailors to participate as a test before the North American World.

3 Request for the rule revision process

Two rules change have been submitted since the 2017 Gamagori World. The first is a vote for the Compass Rules, and the second is a vote announced in January 2019 and changed in April. In Japan, based on the JTA Code, JTA's attitude toward draft rule amendments needs to be decided by holding an extraordinary general meeting and voting.

To vote this time, JTA needs to translate into Japanese the draft rules, prepare supplementary explanations for matters not common in Japan, and give guidance on extraordinary general meetings (guidance on Internet voting), and so forth. The deadline for voting on March 2 was tight. Also, because we were in the off-season, we could not make an opportunity to explain directly to the members, and we felt that the members were not well informed. As a result, the number of votes did not increase, and we struggled to collect the prescribed number of votes (one third of the total number of members). For this reason, in the future when we have rule revision voting, while providing information to each region in advance, we request the setting of the voting deadline with an enough margin.

In addition, in this rule revision vote, it was necessary to make the revised rules effective in July of 2019, before the opening of the World, we understand that there was a circumstance to proceed with the procedure swiftly.

World Masters Games 2021 KANSAL

The first World Masters Games were held in 1985. It was in Toronto, Canada. Since then, sports events have been held every 4 years in Denmark, Australia, the United States and other countries, with a total of 170,000 sports enthusiasts taking part. The World Masters Games will be held in Japan in 2021 for the first time in Asia. 35 sports and 59 events will be held in the Kansai region of Japan, sailing competitions will be held at Wakayama Sailing Center, and TASAR CLASS will be adopted as Two Person Dinghy.

The awards are presented for each category of 2 individuals with a total age of 60 - 89, 90 - 109, 110 - 129, 130 - 149, and over 150.

The highest overall score is also awarded.
